**S.F. No. 967 – Appropriating Money for the Summer Academic
Enrichment Program**

S.F. No. 967 doubles the appropriation from \$250,000 per year to \$500,000 per year for the summer academic enrichment program. The program was established in 2015 to provide stipends, not to exceed \$1,000 per student, to students in grades 3 through 12 who meet the requirements for free or reduced-price school meals, to attend summer enrichment programs that are approved by Office of Higher Education. To be approved, the program must provide as its primary purpose academic instruction for student enrichment in core curricular areas and cannot be used for remedial instruction.
