1.3 Eagle Scout.

1.4 **WHEREAS**, the Eagle Scout rank is the highest rank earned in the Boy Scouts of America;

1.5 and

1.6 **WHEREAS**, attaining the rank of Eagle Scout in Scouts BSA is an important achievement

1.7 that is worthy of recognition; and

1.8 **WHEREAS**, Anders Brovold is a member of the Boy Scouts of America Troop 9323 and

1.9 has displayed the attributes of a responsible and serving member; and

1.10 **WHEREAS**, Anders has demonstrated mastery of all Scouting skills and has completed a

1.11 community service project, which involved building houses for the avian wildlife at Ney Nature

1.12 Center in Henderson, Minnesota, and fulfilled all other requirements necessary to attain the rank

1.13 of Eagle Scout. The project included building six bluebird houses, two bat houses, two kestrel

1.14 boxes, and a chimney swift tower to help accommodate the growing population of wildlife at the

1.15 center and replace some houses at the center that had fallen into disrepair; and

1.16 **WHEREAS**, an Eagle Court of Honor was held on April 24, 2022; and

1.17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Senate of the State of Minnesota that it

1.18 congratulates Anders Brovold of New Prague, Minnesota, for attaining the rank of Eagle Scout.
