A Senate resolution

congratulating Magnus Baker of Avon, Minnesota, for earning the rank of Eagle Scout.

WHEREAS, the Eagle Scout rank is the highest rank earned in the Boy Scouts of America;
and

WHEREAS, attaining the rank of Eagle Scout in Scouts BSA is an important achievement
that is worthy of recognition; and

WHEREAS, Magnus Baker is a member of the Boy Scouts of America Troop 31 and has
displayed the attributes of a responsible and serving member; and

WHEREAS, Magnus has demonstrated mastery of all Scouting skills and has completed a
community service project that involved gathering supplies for people at a board and care home,
where approximately 80 percent of the residents are veterans, most of whom were homeless prior
to moving into the home. He gathered 1,380 pounds of clothing, personal hygiene supplies, and
quilts to donate to the residents; and

WHEREAS, Magnus also coordinated three trips to deliver donated furniture to the care
home, and he fulfilled all other requirements necessary to attain the rank of Eagle Scout; and

WHEREAS, an Eagle Court of Honor will be held on April 21, 2024, at 5 p.m. at Our Savior
Lutheran Church in Albany; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of Minnesota that it
congratulates Magnus Baker of Avon, Minnesota, for attaining the rank of Eagle Scout.
